I am a community member who is very concerned about Pacific Collegiate School. I am writing to day to ask you to do three things:

1. Please begin immediate oversight of Pacific Collegiate School board to insure our public money is being spent appropriately. Make sure they understand their responsibilities as a public school.
2. Do not allow PCS to change their charter to exclude students further. Their charter states that they serve “students of Santa Cruz County and outlying areas”. Do not let them target SCCS in a predatory way by exclusively allowing SCCS students in to PCS.
3. Expect PCS to follow its own diversity task force recommendations to make sure PCS student population reflects the diversity of the county in which it is chartered as per charter law.

PCS is a public school and must have the accountability we expect for all our public schools. Please do your best to make sure this happens.
